I. Meeting called to order by James Michel at 6:05pm.

II. Board Chair Comments:

(1) Location of Board Meetings should be put on February Board Meeting Agenda.

III. Executive Directors Report:

(1) Scholar Recognition Presentation- Dr. Monroe recognized three scholars for their contributions to the community, school life and academic achievement: Andre Davis from T.E.D, Christin Hurey from H.C. and Roman Mitchell from S.M.A.R.T. Board members greeted parents and scholars at 6:20pm. Meeting was called back to order at 6:32pm.

(2) NAYEC Accreditation- Teachers and AA's will need to be certified through NAYEC. Charter School Network will assist Jumoke with this process.

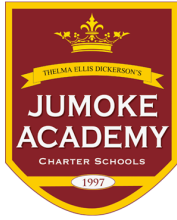
(3) 2016 Jumoke Gala – The board's support was requested and the attire was conveyed as cocktail attire for the evening.

(5) Capital Improvement Plan Update- Dr. Monroe provided the board with a review of CIP costs associated with improving our facilities.
